The Expo is situated in a high profile position adjacent to the Race Central Marquee in the centre of Lake Wanaka township and on the lakefront.

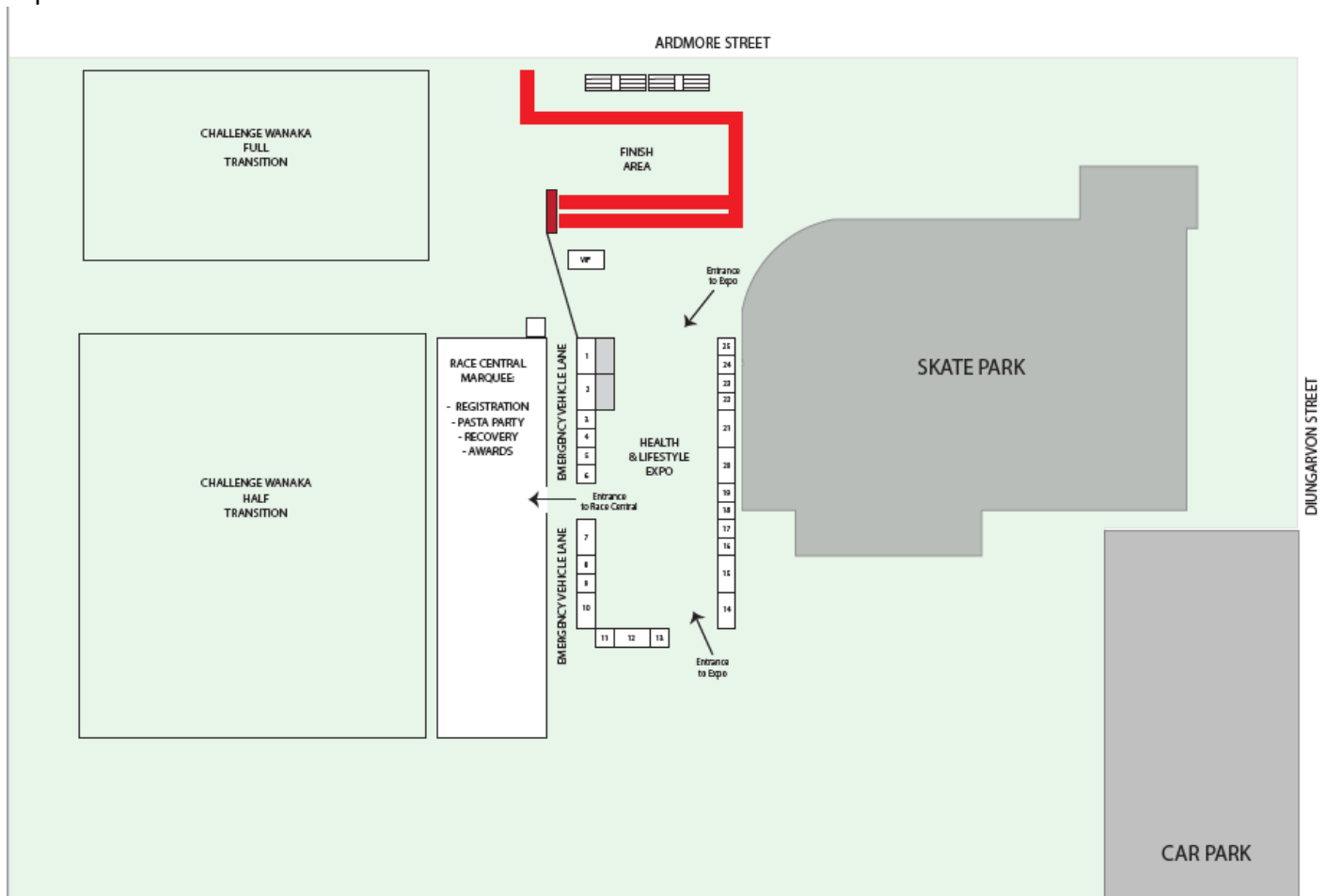
Expo Promotion

2017 Expo Layout

2017 Challenge Wanaka brings some new exciting changes to the Expo layout. We have listened to your feedback and based on this we have changed the site location and layout to ensure the Expo has improved accessibility to maximise foot traffic. Athlete flow will now enter the Race Central Marquee via the Expo. All exhibitors and 3 day food vendors will be located in this new location. Saturday only food vendors will be located between the Skate Park and Ardmore St in the previous Expo area.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Schedule and exhibition spaces

The Challenge Wanaka Expo will take place on Pembroke Park, adjacent to Race Central.
The expo will be open to the general public during the following hours;

- Thursday 16 February 9.00am to 4.00pm. You are welcome to setup from 7.00am.
- Friday, 17 February from 8.30am to 6.00pm
- Saturday 18 February from 9.00am – 2.00pm

Costs

Each exhibitor is responsible for making their own provisions for all expo equipment outside of the provided marquee, tables and chairs

Exhibition spaces for the three days cost:

- 3m x 3m \$675 + GST
- 3m x 6m \$1,150 + GST
- 3m x 9m \$1,600 + GST

Food and drinks stalls are \$500 + GST for the three days, \$175+GST for the Saturday only and will be set up in a separate area to the main expo. Note, No power is available for food stalls on Saturday only.

Community groups with charity status can apply for a reduced stall rate of \$160+GST
Depending on sponsorship level, sponsors are entitled to free stalls.

Provision for power to sites

Expo Sites - Please indicate if you require power at your booth. Power will be provided to the site via a generator, please detail your power requirements

Food Stalls - All food stalls must detail their power requirements and Saturday only will need to supply their own power.

Setup and breakdown of the booths

Exhibitors will be able to set up their own booths on Thursday 16 February from 7.00am to 9.00am. Vehicle access to booths is available during set up and breakdown. Vehicles must be parked off-site in a car park adjacent during all other times.

The Expo will end at 2pm on Saturday 18 February. The teardown of the booths must not be done before 6pm but must be completed by 8pm on Saturday 20 February. The exhibition spaces must be left in a clean and empty condition. The exhibitor is responsible for the removal of all waste and packaging materials from their site. Waste/rubbish may not be left on site otherwise the exhibitor will incur a cleaning/rubbish removal charge of \$100+GST.

Deadline for registration

The deadline for exhibitors to register for a stall space at Challenge Wanaka is 31 January 2016. Any late registrations will be at the discretion of the Event Directors and will incur a \$100+GST late fee. Exhibitors will be informed of the location of their stalls a minimum of two weeks before the event.

Right of withdrawal

If the exhibitor withdraws from his/her registration by 31 January 2016, he/she will be charged 35% of the total expo booth cost.

No withdrawal from the registration is possible after 31 January 2016.

Exclusivity

Exclusivity cannot be granted however acceptance of registration is at the discretion of the Event Directors and may be denied if they are deemed inappropriate.

Legal requirements

Food stalls must comply with the law as enforced by Queenstown Lakes District Council and must apply for and receive the necessary licenses through Lakes Environmental. Once approved a copy of the Hawkers license must be sent to the event directors and must also be displayed by the stall holder on site during the event. Sites will not be allocated to food stalls until a copy of the license has been received by Challenge Wanaka Sports Trust.

Terms of payment

Payment is to be made when expo registration forms are submitted.

The registration will only be accepted after full payment has been received by internet banking, cash or Invoice available on request.

Responsibility for exhibited items and booth equipment

Challenge Wanaka and its agents do not assume any responsibility for exhibit items or booth equipment, and does not accept any liability for damage or lost items.

Security will be present at race central overnight however it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that all stock and valuable items are removed from the premises when unattended by the stall holder.

Force majeure

In case of force majeure, the organiser is entitled to postpone, shorten, partially or completely close or cancel the expo. In these cases the exhibitors/hirers may be entitled to receive a reimbursement or a reduction after all of the costs incurred by the organizers related to the expo have been covered.
