

2026 PUZZLING WORLD MINI CHALLENGE WĀNAKA

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY



Acceptance of terms and conditions

By completing registration to enter your child in the Puzzling World Mini Challenge Wānaka (the **Event**), which is organised by The Challenge Wānaka Sports Trust (the **Organiser**), you accept the following terms and conditions.

Age restrictions

On the date of the Event, the child must be 5 years or younger.

As the parent or legal guardian, you must complete the registration process on behalf of your child and must accept full responsibility for their compliance with these terms and conditions.

Acknowledgment of risks

By entering your child into the Event, you acknowledge that:

- competing involves risks, which include: using a water slide, biking and running on uneven surfaces (grass) and in public areas used by other people and traffic;
- the Organiser has done its best to make the Event as safe as possible, considering that the Organiser cannot control every eventuality;
- participation is at your own risk, knowing that participating in the Event can cause injury, damage to equipment or death;
- failure to comply with the race briefing or officials' instructions may result in being removed from the Event and disqualified;
- the entry fee is non-refundable if: the Event is cancelled or stopped for any reason, or personal circumstances prevent your child from participating in or completing the Event;
- the Organiser is not liable for anything resulting from your child's entry or participation in the Event.

Your responsibilities as a parent/legal guardian of a participant

You confirm that your child:

- is able to walk unassisted;
- will attend the race briefing prior to the Event;
- will be instructed to follow the course set out for the Event and instructions given by Event officials;
- will be instructed to respect all other participants, officials, volunteers and spectators.

Medical Treatment

If your child suffers an injury, accident or illness during the Event, you:

- consent to them receiving medical treatment;
- will allow information regarding their medical treatment to be given to the Organiser and others involved in organising the Event;
- will pay all costs associated with their medical care and transportation;

Use of the child's image and information

You allow the use of your child's name, voice and image to be used in the media and for marketing purposes and for the purpose of promoting future or other events and promoting the Event charity, race sponsors, products and services.

You allow your information to be added to the Organiser's database and being automatically subscribed to various emails and publications. You can, however, opt out of receiving these communications.

Prizes and other benefits

The Organiser has absolute discretion in awarding prizes, prize money or third party prizes or awards. The Organiser may provide gifts or other benefits as part of the entry but cannot guarantee their availability. No gift or benefit is transferrable or able to be exchanged or cashed in.

Complaints

If you have a complaint concerning the Event or these terms and condition, you:

- will first raise the complaint with the Organiser with the objective of reaching an acceptable agreement within 14 days;
- will not discuss the complaint with anyone else, recognising that you could otherwise jeopardise the future of the Event;
- If agreement cannot be reached within 14 days, agree that the matter will be referred to mediation.

Changes to terms and conditions

The Organiser may revise these terms and conditions by updating its website and may change the content, links or functionality of the website at any time. Your child's participation in the Event will constitute your acceptance of the revised terms and conditions.

New Zealand law applies to the Event and these terms and conditions.
